# 1. IMW KICK-STARTER DIPLOMA

## inMusic Production 20 weeks

### Course Details

If you want to work in the sound recording industries, record your own music or you would like to see if this is the career for you and plan to go on to our higher education HND in Music Production, then this course is for you!

The aim of this intensive Diploma course is to give you a qualification in music making/ sound recording and music production on SSL consoles running Logic Pro, Pro Tools and Native Instruments software and give musician/bands. You will be able to take that next step in the industry or apply to our intensive higher education programme

You will also increase your confidence and competence across all contemporary music production techniques that include rehearsing, recording and mixing using: our SSL 48 channel Duality and AWS948 consoles; Pro Tools and Logic Pro; workstation based electronic music composition using Logic Pro and Ableton software; hands-on workstation production techniques using the SSL Nucleus control surface.

The main course takes place in our SSL AWS/Nucleus studios running Pro Tools, Logic and Ableton software and rehearsal studios at City and Islington College. It includes sessions on the production of live/electronic music including composition, beat building, sampling and synthesis. It will also provide an introduction to techniques associated with creating sound and music for film. The course includes demonstrations and sessions in the SSL Duality SE/ProTools HD studio, covering practical recording and sound theory.

We have taken great care to ensure that you will get the individual hands-on practice to enable you to fulfil the requirements of the course. The course is designed around the realities of pre-production, recording/mix sessions and post production and introduces the skills you need to meet the demands of working in a

### The course covers:

1. Sound Studio practice: recording live musicians using SSL consoles; monitoring, equalisation, dynamics and effects, console configuration, track management, overdubs, mixing, mic techniques and sound theory.
2. Computer sequencing: track and beat building, comparative platforms, and programs focusing on Logic, ProTools and Native Instruments; arrangement and editing of sequences; production techniques and sound processing; synthesis and sound design techniques; file management and mastering.
3. Sampling and Digital Audio: overview of software samplers and editing techniques; using and editing audio loops and library SFX; audio layering and synthesis for sound design; integration of sampling for production and post production.
4. Two projects based around live recordings and electronic music production with an option to create a sound and music to picture project.

You will receive the qualification because you will have produced a portfolio of competent written course work, successful practical assignments and a show reel of 2 projects. You will have satisfied IMW that you have reached the high level of competence required to pass all the modules in this course.

#### Assignments

##### 'Year' 1 / HNC / Level 4

The first 27 weeks of study will enhance your core musical/technical skills in music production and the use of key SSL technology: Nucleus, Matrix, AWS948 and the Duality controlling ProTools, Logic and Native Instruments.

You will explore techniques in musicianship/ music production and sound engineering in a variety of contexts including music production, sound recording live musicians, video games sound production and film sound production.

You will also develop critical skills in playing/listening, research and analysis of music and production.

- Music and Production in Context
- Sound and Music Technology Systems
- Sound Design for Film/Games Project
- Music Recording Project
- Production Portfolio of above projects

##### 'Year' 2 / HND / Level 5
